• St. Mary's College asks that all parents/guardians consider the level of commitment that is required for the AP program. It is strongly recommended that discussions of this commitment take place with their son/daughter prior to applying to the AP Program.

• The Advanced Placement program extends beyond that of the regular Ontario Curriculum and requires a full commitment to academic studies.

• Respectfully, parents are requested to consider all aspects in terms of commitment when deciding to support their child's application to avoid disappointment and/or confusion.

• It is noted that Grade 12 Advanced Placement courses are equivalent to first year university level and therefore require students to be prepared to study material that may be more challenging than Grade 12 University level course work.
