The Board makes available an Accident and Life Insurance Program for students. Participation in such a program is voluntary and the costs are to be paid by the parent or guardian. If you have not already received a brochure, please contact your school.

The Board has arranged a Student Accident Insurance Policy exclusively through Old Republic Canada. This program offers a variety of plans and benefits including:

- dental expenses (resulting from an accident)
- total and permanent disability
- paralysis/loss of use
- special disability benefits
- death benefits
