COURSE DETAILS

What?	The Additional Qualification Course Mathematics, Primary and Junior, Part 1 explores in a holistic and integrated manner theoretical foundations, learning theory, program planning, development and implementation, instructional design and practices, assessment and evaluation, the learning environment, research, and ethical considerations related to teaching and learning across the divisions. Through these explorations, candidates strengthen professional efficacy by gaining in-depth knowledge, refining professional judgement and generating new knowledge for practice.
Who?	This course is open to any OCT member with a Certificate of Qualification and Registration who holds qualifications in the Primary or Junior division, or a qualification in the Intermediate or Senior division in a general education subject from the OCT's Schedule A. Note: This course may be audited (no credit granted) by non-teachers.
How?	This course will be offered through online delivery through the Learning Management System (LMS). Candidates are required to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have access to reliable technology (i.e., computer, Internet connection). • Access online course materials at least three times a week, complete all assignments, and participate substantively in all virtual activities—approximately 5–7 hours per week.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

Course tuition is \$450 for OCT members: \$100 for non-OCT members (audit only; no credit granted). Expenses related to participant texts, connectivity, and equipment are not included.

Fees may be paid by cheque by May 28, 2018. Cheques should be made out to the ; Huron-Superior Catholic District School Board. **HSCDSB employees may also pay through payroll deduction** (initiated prior to course start).

NOTE: The Ministry of Education currently offers all teachers who successfully complete an AQ course in mathematics a \$450 subsidy.
