POLICY

The Huron Superior Catholic District School Board will provide the highest quality of goods and services as efficiently and cost effectively as possible. In keeping with Catholic social teaching and our Mission Statement, the Board recognizes that the overall cost may include non-monetary factors such as impact on the environment, labour practices, service standards and energy efficiency.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- The Board believes in the fair and equitable treatment of vendors and as such, adheres to the Ontario Ministry of Finance Integrated Supply Chain Management Guidelines and the laws of Ontario and Canada.
- The Board encourages vendors to obtain products that have been verified to be
 manufactured without utilizing child labour and in accordance with ethical manufacturing
 practices. Suppliers must agree to provide full disclosure and independent monitoring of
 manufacturing processes, if requested by the Board.
- The Board supports "green" products and services. All criteria being equal, preference will be given to environmentally friendly products and services.
- Where, in the opinion of the Board, little disparity exists regarding quality and/or cost, preference will be given to goods made in Canada.
- The Board encourages and promotes standardization of products throughout the Board.
- The Board believes in and participates in, cooperative purchasing with other Broader Public Sector (BPS) partners as recommended by the Ministry of Finance Supply Chain Guideline and Ontario Buys.
