POLICY TITLE: DISASTER RECOVERY Approved: March 21, 2018

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POLICY

The Huron-Superior Catholic District School Board acknowledges the sacredness of all life and the importance of providing an enduring education that reflects Catholic traditions. The Board seeks to ensure that, in the event of a disaster, it is prepared to continue operations as quickly and effectively as possibly. A disaster is defined as an event, either caused by human or nature, which can cause operations to cease, because of, but not limited to, the following:

- Damage to or destruction of facilities
- Damage to or loss of computer software and programs
- Damage to or loss of digital data
- Damage to or loss of paper data

The Board's priority, should a disaster occur, is the safety of all staff, students, parents, and others who may be in its schools or facilities.
