Cell Phones: As per Board Policy, Elementary students (Grade JK through Grade 8) are prohibited from using PEDs for telephone calls or texting/messaging. All elementary students requiring home communication for emergency purposes must use the telephone system provided in the main office. The exception is when authorized school personnel (e.g., teacher, principal/vice-principal) have permitted the use of a PED to make a telephone call or text/message in the case of urgency or extenuating circumstances.



End of Day Pick Up: In accordance with amended parking by-law 2014-180 for the City of Sault Ste. Marie parking is prohibited on both sides of Gibbs Street as it restricts the flow of traffic. It is also a safety concern for students who are crossing in front of traffic to reach vehicles parked on the opposite side. **Parents are not permitted to park on Gibbs Street to drop off or pick up students.**

Please be mindful of the flow of traffic, pulling ahead as space allows. The pick-up will remain a single-lane. A teacher will approach your vehicle to confirm the student(s) being picked up and communicate this to the office for the child to be dismissed. Parents are asked when possible to remain in their vehicles at all times and to remember safe distance and masking rules.
