<u>June 24 - Tropical Day</u> - Show us your unique style while wearing your favourite shades/sunglasses.





June Messages

Dress Code

As the weather warms up, we remind our school community of the dress code policy, as follows.

Students, staff, parents, and visitors to the school should dress respectfully at school and school-sponsored events. We expect common sense to be the key criterion in determining what is acceptable. However, it should be known that the following shall be enforced:

- Clothing displaying racist, sexist, offensive, drug or alcohol related slogans or images is not permitted
- Bare midriffs, short shorts, micro minis, spaghetti straps on tops or dresses, halter tops, backless shirts or blouses and transparent clothing are not acceptable
- Shorts and skirts must be mid thigh length
- Intentionally torn or ripped clothing will not be allowed
- Hats, hoods, bandanas, and sunglasses will be allowed only in the school yard
- Foot wear should support the foot to prevent injury thus sandals should have a back strap.

Morning Arrival

Effective immediately, students are no longer required to enter the school prior to the first bell. Upon arrival, all Grade 1-8 students will head directly to the school yard to their designated play area (Primary/Junior/Intermediate). Kindergarten students will enter the school and head to their regular classroom where they will access the gated play area.

We ask that families please continue to use the parent drop off/pick up area on Gibbs Street when dropping off and picking up students. The bus bay must be kept clear for buses, cabs and emergency vehicles only.

Library Books
