The deadline for indicating your desire to transition your child(ren) is **Friday, March 26**. The actual transition date is **Monday, April 26**.

Students Currently Enrolled in Virtual Learning

If your child(ren) are currently enrolled in our elementary or secondary virtual academies and you wish to have them remain there until the end of June 2021, there is nothing more you need to do. Your virtual instruction will continue.

Students Currently Enrolled in In-Person Learning

If your child(ren) are currently enrolled in in-person learning at a local school and you wish to have them remain learning in person until the end of June 2021, there is nothing more you need to do. Your in-person instruction will continue.

If your child(ren) are currently enrolled in in-person learning at a local school and you wish to have them transition to one of our virtual academies on Monday, April 26, please contact your local principal or vice-principal by **Friday, March 26** to ensure appropriate arrangements are made.

As always, we recognize it might be difficult to make a commitment when health conditions are in flux. If you feel unable to make this decision by the March 26 deadline and you express a desire to transition after that date, we will add your name to a wait list and try our best to accommodate you. However, please understand we cannot guarantee that we will be able to do so.

On a related note, our board is in the process of planning for the 2021-22 school year. We want to ensure that all necessary supports and resources are in place for the next school year, and we will be in touch with you later this spring with additional information.

In closing, please accept our board's appreciation for your continued cooperation and support. We urge all of you to continue to observe all public health measures, particularly those related to travel and social gatherings, and especially over the upcoming Holy Week, Easter long weekend, and spring break. Your ongoing adherence to public health advice, commitment to the common good, and prayers for everyone's safety are greatly appreciated.
