POLICY

In its mission, the Huron-Superior Catholic District School Board recognizes the individuality and sacredness of each student. To serve the needs of all its students – including those with special needs – and to comply with policies and program requirements established by the Ministry of Education, the Board has established a Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) policy.

Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) for mature students provides a process by which the prior experiences of adult learners, both formal and informal, can be recognized for secondary credit, minimizing duplication of learning, saving the learner time and opportunity costs, and providing them with an enhanced pathway to high school graduation.
