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POLICY

The Huron-Superior Catholic District School Board believes that all students are called to become self-directed, responsible, lifelong learners; to become moral, responsible, and contributing members of society; and to perform paid and/or volunteer work that honours their God-given gifts. The Board also believes in the dignity of various kinds of work (e.g., skilled trades, self-employment, public service) and recognizes there are many pathways to personal fulfilment and success.

Grounded in these beliefs, the Huron-Superior Catholic District School Board supports the implementation of the Ministry of Education's (2013) *Creating Pathways to Success: An Education and Career/Life Planning Program for Ontario Schools.* This document requires all district school boards to establish a comprehensive Kindergarten to Grade 12 program so all students can be supported as they:

- Identify their personal interests, strengths, needs, and aspirations.
- Engage in varied learning opportunities that meet their interests and goals.
- Achieve personal goals and become competent, successful, and contributing members of society.
- Create clear plans for their individual pathways through school.
- Make successful transitions to postsecondary destinations (e.g., apprenticeship training, college, community living, university, workplace).

Such support may be provided by parents/guardians, employees of the Board, and/or the broader community.

The Huron Superior Catholic District School Board also recognizes that the requirements in the *Creating Pathways to Success: An Education and Career/Life Planning Program for Ontario Schools* document were modified by the Ministry of Education in January 2017. These modifications have been taken into account in the procedural guidelines.
