POLICY

The Huron-Superior Catholic District School Board recognizes and believes that we are called and committed to mutually invite, encourage and support our families, our Church and our community in our efforts to provide excellence in Catholic education. It is our mission to develop Catholic learning communities that develop the full potential of each child while nurturing a personal relationship with Jesus.

The Huron-Superior Catholic District School Board endorses the ethical and responsible use of existing and emerging technologies to promote educational excellence, efficiencies in management and communication, and cooperation through resource sharing and access to information. It is the policy of the Board that Information Technology be used in a manner that is in support of education and educational research, while maintaining security of the system and data at all times.

The Board provides access to its computer network and resources to students in support of their learning, research requirements and career preparation, to educators in support of their instruction, research, professional development and administrative activities, to staff in support of their assigned responsibilities, and to other authorized users including trustees.

In providing access to a global network, the Board recognizes its limitations in fully controlling access to inappropriate information and interactions. The Board has taken reasonable precautions to restrict access to controversial materials. The users of the Board's network are required to adhere to the Board's Procedural Guidelines to ensure responsible use of the Board's computer network.

The accompanying Procedural Guidelines and Forms outline a comprehensive, detailed approach of the Huron-Superior Catholic District School Board *Acceptable Use of Information and Communication Technology Resources*.
