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## **POLICY**

The Community Use of Schools Policy of the Huron-Superior Catholic School Board was instituted to make facilities of the Board available to the community at large. The main thrust is to provide enrichment programs to the students and adults of the jurisdiction and make Board facilities available to local groups and organizations.

Board facilities shall only be used for appropriate activities that are consistent with Our Mission.

The Community Use of Schools Program is established by the Board to:

- 1) Promote culture-enriching activities within the community.
- 2) Support areas of community need that are enhanced by further education.
- 3) Provide access to buildings and facilities needed by the community for their activities.
- 4) Meet the student and adult needs of the community which are not met by our day school programs.
- 5) Operate programs according to procedures approved by the Board.
