## Lead Exceedance Public Notice Flushed Sample – [Month, Year]

To all families at [School Name]:

Ontario's Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks requires schools, private schools and child care centres to conduct regular testing for lead in drinking water.

A plumbing fixture at your child's school was sampled and subsequently exceeded the current standard of 10 micrograms per litre on a flushed sample.

## **Corrective Actions**

- The fixture was removed from service.
- [local health unit], Ministry of Education, and Ministry of Environment, Conservation, and Parks notified.
- Continued enhanced daily flushing of school plumbing fixtures.

## Outcome

Planning is underway to assess options and implement corrective actions as soon as possible. Once repair(s) / modifications have been made, the fixture will be re-tested.

Once the issue(s) are resolved, a Notice of Resolution will be distributed to the school community.
