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POLICY

The Huron-Superior Catholic District School Board is committed to developing the full potential of each student. We recognize that a student's health and well-being significantly contributes to their ability to attend school and learn.

While keeping students connected with their home school, home instruction supports the delivery of educational programs by providing differentiated and relevant learning opportunities. Students who are not able to attend school for medical reasons and/or special circumstances (e.g., social, emotional, behavioural or legal issues that prevent school attendance) may be eligible for home instruction services. Such instruction may be provided when requested by the school Principal or designate on the confirmed absence by a doctor and approved by the appropriate Supervisory Officer in compliance with the other conditions of the Ministry of Education.
