IDENTIFICATION OF STUDENTS FOR SCHOOL RELATED ACTIVITIES FORM

In keeping with its mandate under the Education Act, the Huron-Superior Catholic District School Board recognizes individual student achievements and milestones by way of announcements, honour rolls, displays, mention in newsletters, public/social media, awards assemblies, graduate lists, printed programs and other public documents or events. Recognitions may include personal information about an identifiable student such as their name, grade, achievement and may include their photograph.

In accordance with the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act and the Education Act, and in order to ensure the protection of personal privacy, written consent is required for the use and disclosure of personal information as outlined above. Consent is required from the student who is at least sixteen (16) years old. For students under the age of sixteen (16), consent from their parent/guardian is required. You are therefore requested to read and sign the attached consent form.
